To Whom It May Concern,

All markets in Borsa İstanbul are planned to serve on a single trading platform within the framework of strategic partnership agreement signed between Borsa İstanbul A.Ş. and NASDAQ on 20/01/2014.

Within the scope of the first phase of “Transformation Through Technology Program”, the transformation process has been implemented with Borsa İstanbul stakeholders. The first phase of the project was completed and Equity Market transactions started to be successfully performed on BISTECH Trading Platform on November 30, 2015.

In the second phase of the project, Derivatives Market (VIOP) systems will be migrated to BISTECH. As part of this migration, there will be changes in the Order Transmission and Data Dissemination Protocols for VIOP.

The updated BISTECH protocol specifications (ROE) and the document highlighting specification differences between Phase 1 and Phase 2 versions will be available at <http://www.borsaistanbul.com/en/bistechsupport/technical-documents> on March 25, 2016.

Additionally there will be a briefing on March 30, 2016 at Borsa İstanbul Conference Hall about Derivatives Market's migration to BISTECH, changes in order transmission and data dissemination protocols, time schedule for readiness and cut-over related activities. All members, data vendors and ISVs are encouraged to attend the briefing which will be held in Turkish but its slides will be translated into English and published on Borsa İstanbul's web site.
