Subject: About Responsible Supply Chain Applications of Precious Metals Intermediary Institutions That Are Members of the Exchange Under the Decisions of the Council of State.

To Whom It May Concern

In accordance with the first paragraph of Article 21 of the Regulation on the Principles of Activity of Precious Metals Intermediary Institutions and the Establishment of Precious Metals Intermediary Institutions, for precious metals institutions whose operating license canceled by the Ministry of Treasury and Finance (Ministry) before 2023, and subsequently under the decisions of the 13th Chamber of the Council of State Precious metals intermediary institution whose operating license were given back and re-membership to the Exchange took place within the last 3 months of 2023;

- There is no need to prepare the Supply Chain Compliance Report for 2023 by the end of March 2024 and the Independent Assurance Report, which is assured at a reasonable assurance level, by the end of June 2024 and send it to the Exchange and the Ministry within the specified periods,
- The reports for 2024 must be prepared within the periods specified in the legislation, covering the period from the date of re-membership to the Exchange in 2023, and submitted to the Exchange and the Ministry in 2025.

These issues are important for responsible supply chain practices.
