Subject: Announcement Regarding Changes Made in BIST  
Market Cap Weighted Stock Indices Methodology  
due to the Newly Calculated Indices, BIST  
Dividend 5 Years and BIST Dividend 10 Years

To Whom It May Concern

BIST Stock Indices Methodologies are periodically reviewed by the Borsa İstanbul Financial Benchmarks Committee (Committee), reflecting the developments in the markets and changes arising from local and international legislation, meeting requests received from market participants that are deemed appropriate, and making necessary updates accordingly.

In this context, Borsa İstanbul Management has decided to make the following changes;

- BIST Dividend 5 Years and BIST Dividend 10 Years indices (Indices) will start to be calculated.
- When determining the stocks to be included in the Indices;
  - Companies that distributed positive amount of cash dividends in the last 5 and 10 calendar years, respectively, as of the Review Date, by subtracting rights issue exercised in the same year from the cash dividends, are included in the BIST Dividend 5 Years and BIST Dividend 10 Years indices.
  - The distribution of cash dividends from profit or internal resources; advance, upfront or installment payments don't make any difference in periodic review.
  - Only the cash dividends that are distributed after the shares has started to be traded are taken into account.
  - When determining whether companies have distributed cash dividends for the relevant year, the Ex-Dividend Dates announced on PDP are taken into account. For installment cash dividend payments carried over to the following year, only the year in which the first installment was distributed is taken into account.
  - When determining whether companies have exercised rights issue for the relevant year, Rights Issue Ex-Date announced on PDP are taken into account. For the right issue where Rights Issue End Date is on the next year, Rights Issue Ex-Date is taken into account.
  - Under the "Provisional Article 13 added to Turkish Commercial Code No. 6102" published in the Official Gazette dated April 17, 2020 and numbered 31102, cash dividends distributed by companies, that were unable to distribute cash dividends in 2020, in January or February 2021 shall be deemed to have been distributed in 2020.
  - The indices shall be calculated starting from February 2, 2026 with the codes below and the shares listed in Appendix 1.

- The initial values of the indices shall be the closing value of the BIST Dividend Index (TL – Price) on January 30, 2026.
- To clarify the meaning of Article 10.2 and 10.4 of the BIST Market Cap Weighted Stock Indices Methodology (Methodology), the phrase “upon the recommendation of the Committee” shall be added.
- For all the changes made in the Methodology, the procedures and principles specified in Article 7.6 titled as “Non-Material Changes” of the Borsa İstanbul Financial Benchmarks Management Procedure shall be followed.
- The updated Methodology shall be effective from the February 2, 2026.
