Subject: Announcement on the Custody (KASA)Application Interface Change and Member Training Sessions

Dear Sir/Madam,

An interface change to the KASA application, which is currently used in Borsa İstanbul's Precious Metals Market (PMM), is planned to be implemented on 28 September 2026.

In this context, Borsa İstanbul will organize applied training sessions in order to inform users about the changes made to the application and to provide guidance on the processes relating to its use.
