Currently, according to the BIST Market Cap Weighted Stock Indices Methodology (Methodology), shares traded on the Stars Market, Main Market and Submarket are included in the BIST ALL SHARES Index. It is planned that the Methodology will be revised to allow the inclusion of shares traded on the Pre-Market Trading Platform to the BIST ALL SHARES Index. The comment period ended on 11/07/2023. A total of 2057 comments were submitted, 1832 of which were comments other than the requested subject. The 225 comments submitted according to the requested subject have been summarized, grouped and presented in the table below along with Borsa İstanbul's evaluation of these comments:
